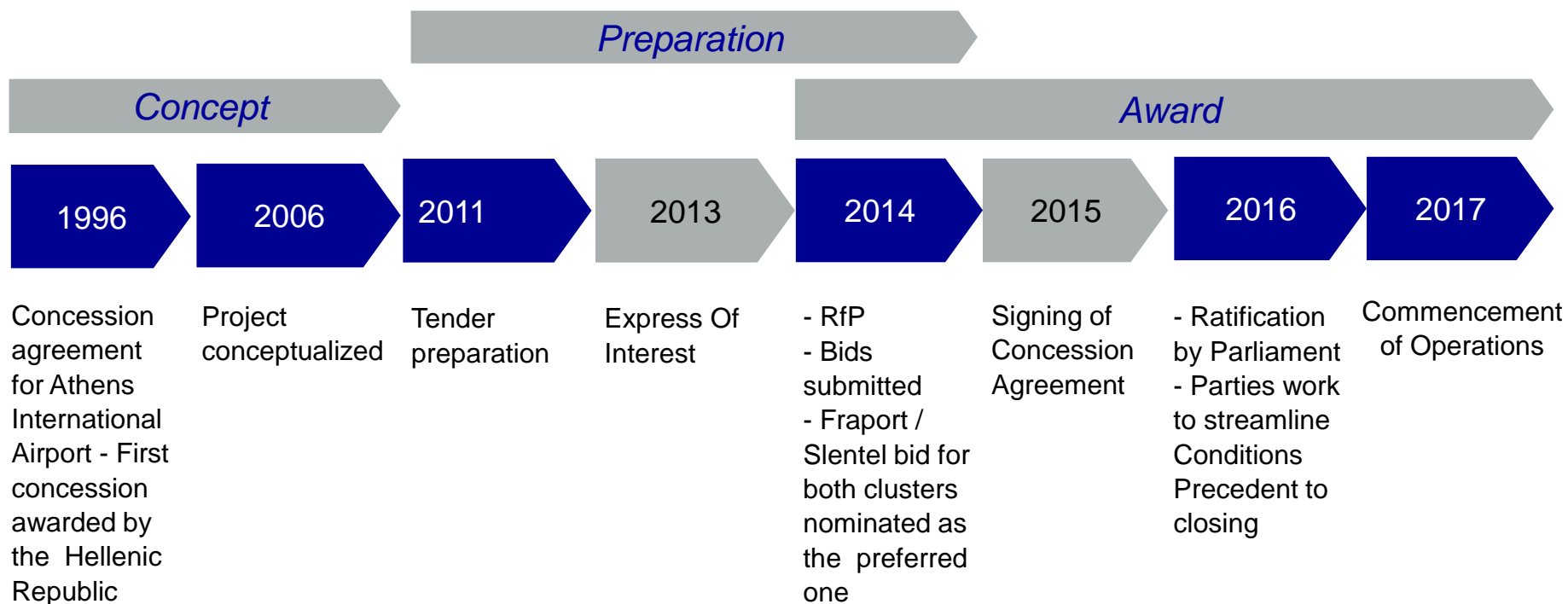

Opening the Path to Development




- One of the largest and most beneficial investments in Greece
- A basis for boosting the Greek economy
- Promotion and development of Greek tourism
- Contributing to the development of local communities

The Concession Project at a Glance

- 40-year concession of 14 regional airports
- Responsible for maintaining, operating, managing, upgrading and developing the 14 airports.
- €1.234 billion upfront concession fee
- Annual fixed concession fee of initially €22.9 million
- Variable annual concession fee of on average 28.5% of operational profit
- Total investment of €400 million in airport infrastructure until 2021
- At least 560 new direct job positions
- Greek state receiving approximately 10 billion euros by the end of the concession

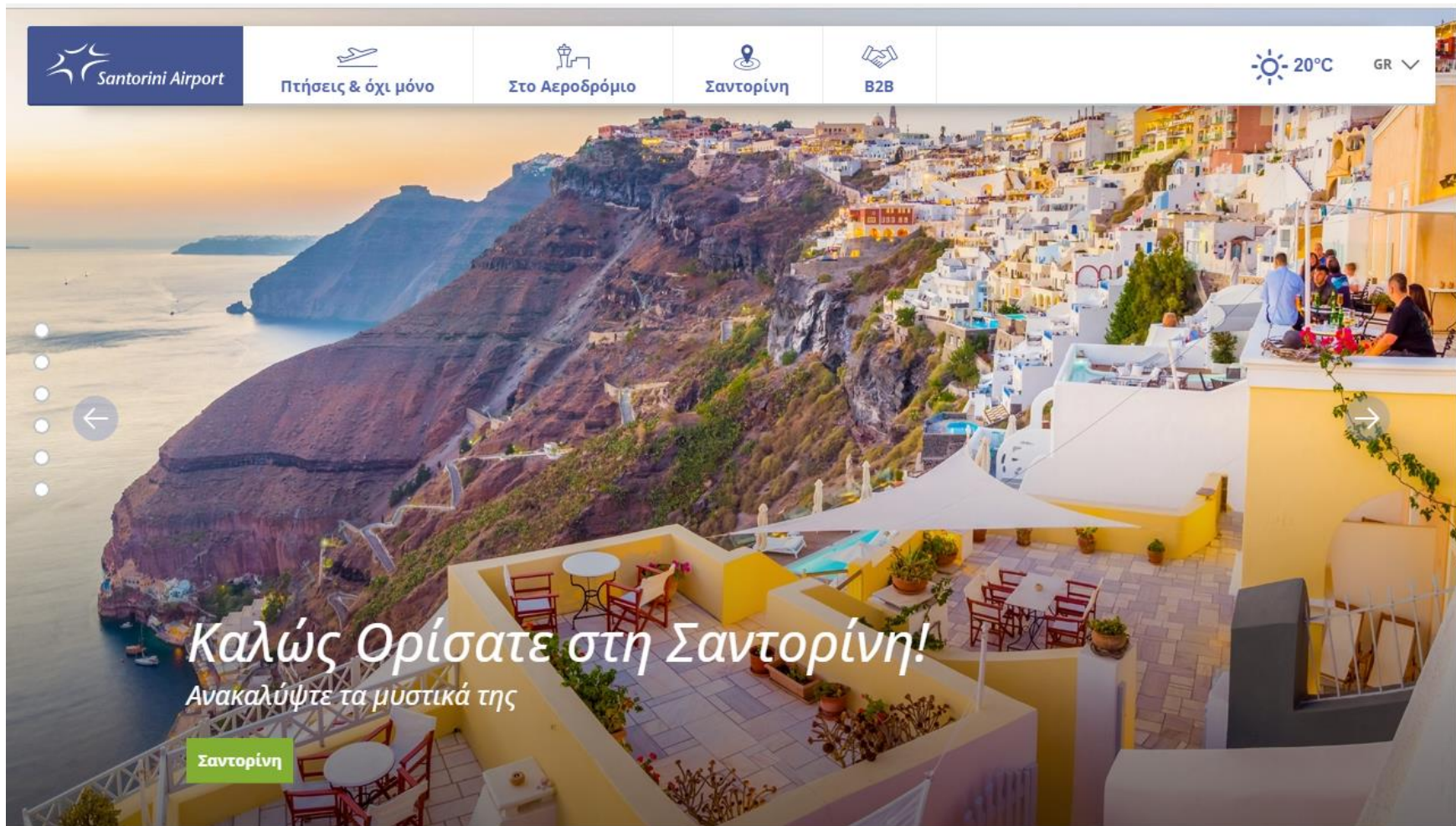

Προφανώς κι η ξελογιάστρα θέα είναι εκεί. Αλλά πυκνοκατοικημένη που προκαλεί συνωστισμό: με ερωτευμένα ζευγαράκια να ανταλλάσσουν όρκους αιώνιας πίστης, καυτά φιλάκια και selfies, με οριεντάλ, bridal χαρούμενες υπάρξεις πάνω σε αξιολάτρευτα τετράποδα και με τους σοφιστικέ θαμώνες να απολαμβάνουν τοπικό οίνο υπό τους ήχους του Παβαρότι. Σαφώς. Είναι όλα κι όλοι εκεί in order, γαντζωμένοι ή κρεμασμένοι από την άκρη της Καλντέρας, εκεί που κάποτε τα εγκαταλελειμμένα σπίτια κατακρημνίζονταν στη θάλασσα, σε σμήνη, να καταβροχθίζουν το παγκόσμιο ηλιοβασίλεμα, χειροκροτώντας τις ακτίνες του ήλιου, τη στιγμή που πεθαίνουν στην αγκαλιά του Ποσειδώνα.

Όπερ ἔδει δείξει: στη Θηραϊκή γη 'Beauty Lies in the Eye of the Beholder' και πηγαίνει αντάμα με την εξέλιξη του πολιτισμού, τις αξίες και τις απαιτήσεις των σύγχρονων κοινωνιών που διαρκώς αλλάζουν.



Η Σαντορίνη, αυτό το μυστηριώδες εργαστήριο του Vulcan, είναι το «νησί-καρπιοστάλ της Ελλάδας». Και είναι ακριβώς αυτή η κατά Μπεντ «συναρπαστικά φρικαλέα ομορφιά» που την ανέβασε στο βάθρο του πιο διάσημου Ελληνικού νησιού.

Ωστόσο, προς υπεράσπιση του Τζέιμς Μπεντ, το άλλοθι είναι η δυαδικότητα, που φαίνεται να είναι ανέκαθεν αποκλειστικό προνόμιο της Σαντορίνης. Η κατά Ελύτη «Κόρη της μεγάλης οργής» υπήρξε πάντα «διαζευκτική». Καλύτερα, είναι ένα διαζευκτικό ολόκληρη.

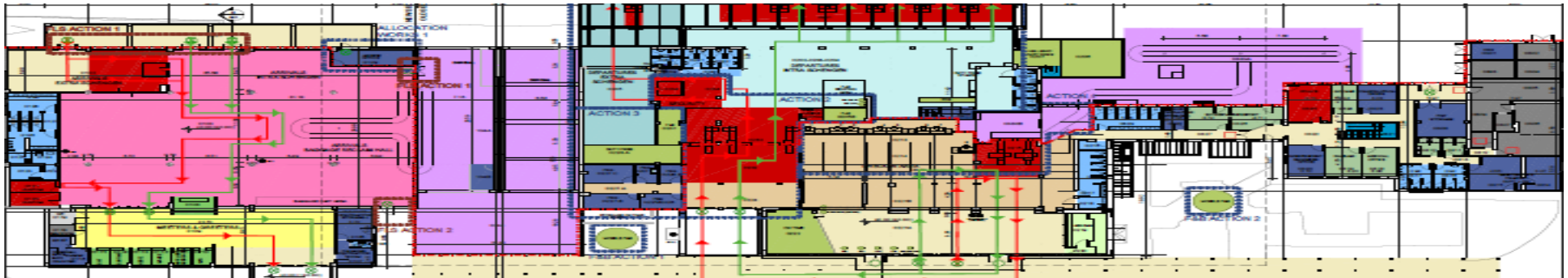

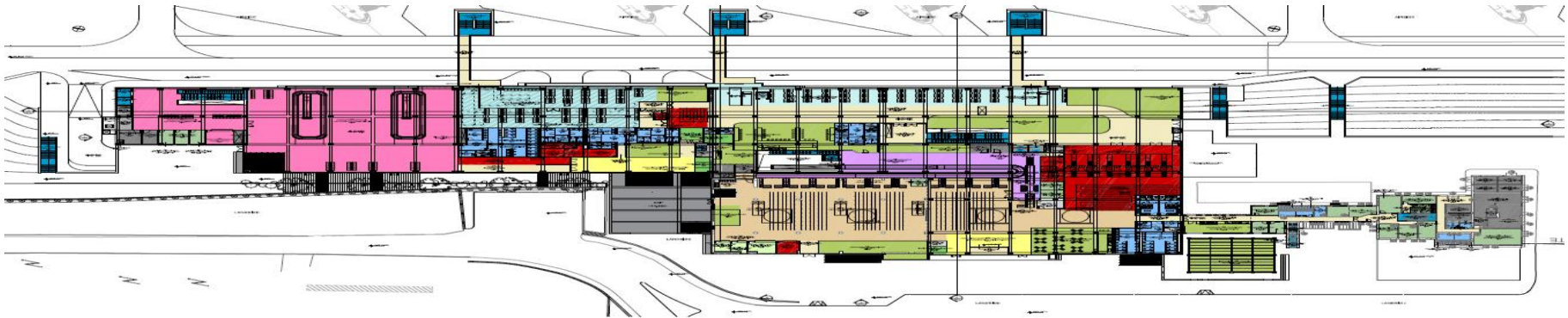
JTR – Transition Phase

- Basic FLS actions (maintenance of evacuation routes, control of fire hazards)
- Deep cleaning of terminals and surrounding areas
- Replacement of locks for offices and technical areas
- Improvements of staff areas allocation
- Repair of x-ray machines
- IT cabling and change of FIDS
- Enhancement of restrooms (unclogging, replacement of worn fixtures, enhancement of ventilation etc.)
- Installation of defibrillators
- Landside actions for parking access and utilization
- Airside actions (rubber removal, markings, AGL inspection and repairs)



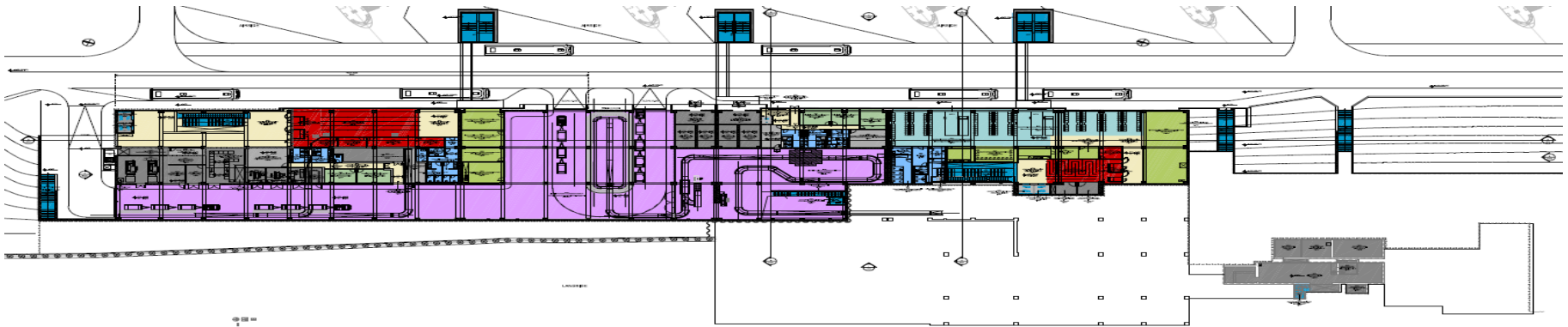
JTR – Imminent Works, Terminal Building Level 1 (Ground Floor)

- Demolition and replacement of the bigger part of the existing terminal; expansion to the northwest
- Separate arrivals and departure processes
- Rearrangement and expansion of the check-in area
- Centralized security check area
- New BHS installations with new reclaim area
- Expansion and remodeling of departure gates
- Fixed passenger bridges for enhanced boarding process
- Expansion and enhancement of the commercial functions
- Complete refurbishment of the Offices / ATC building

- New BHS & HBS installations
- Additional Departure Gates and security areas
- Expansion of the commercial functions
- New Electromechanical installations

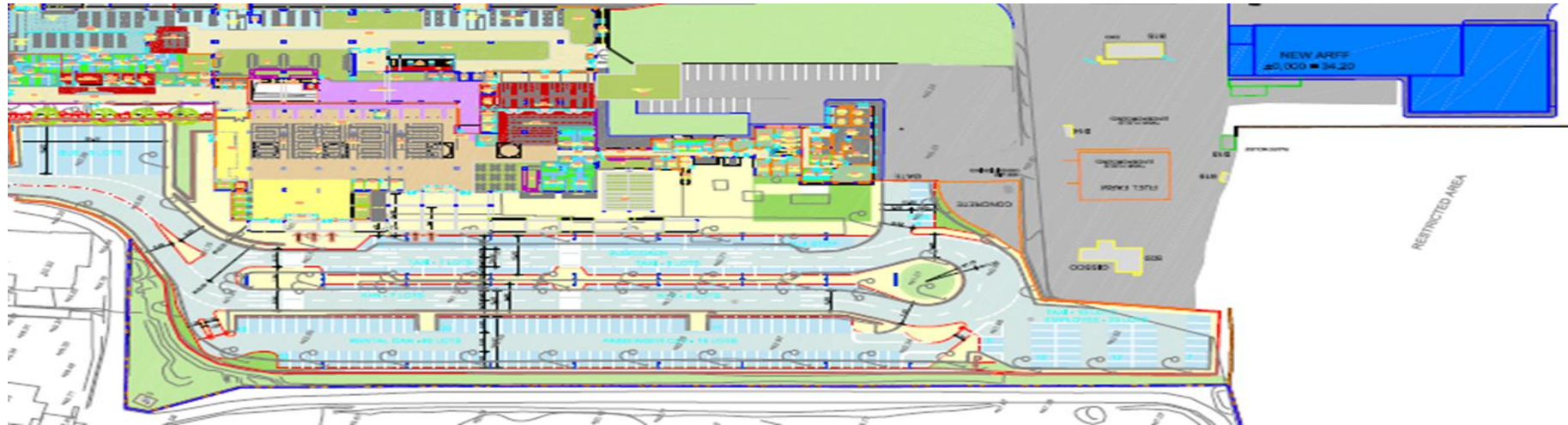
JTR Airside Elevation

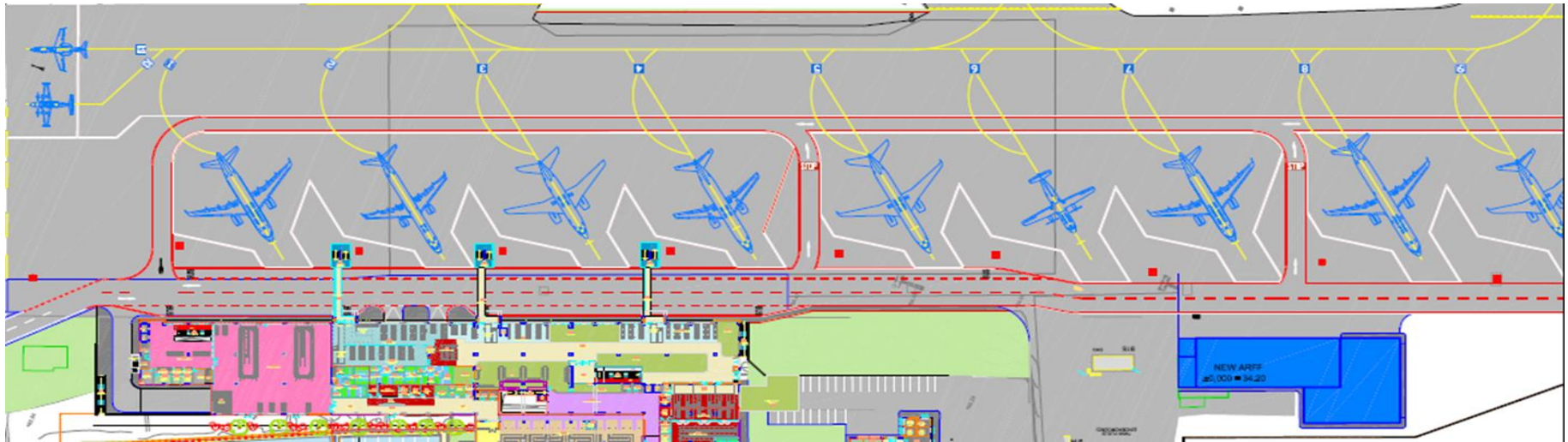
